Terms and conditions for issue of a bowls season ticket

- The season ticket entitles the holder to play on any Council Green at either King George's Playing Fields or Hutton Poplars for one season, subject always to rink availability.
- 2. Applicants will be issued with a letter stating their season ticket number on it. This will act as the holder's season ticket as opposed to a photo id card. The letter should be retained and be available to view at all times as proof of purchase. In the event of failure to produce a season ticket on request, the applicant will not be permitted to play. Parking permits are not issued and parking is available on site at King Georges Playing Fields for bowls season ticket holders in the over flow car park area and at Hutton Poplars adjacent to the Lodge Building.
- 3. Season tickets at a reduced rate are available to all persons over the age of 60 years. Proof of age is required. In the event of a person under 60 obtaining a Senior Citizen's season ticket, the ticket will be cancelled without refund.
- 4. Season tickets at a reduced rate are available to all juniors under the age of 18 years. Proof of age is required. In the event of a person over 18 obtaining a junior season ticket, the ticket will be cancelled without refund.
- 5. Season tickets are not transferable.
- 6. Refunds for unwanted tickets will not be given.
- 7. Season tickets applied for during the season will incur the full season ticket price and are not charged pro rata.
- 8. The Council has authorised its groundsman or agent on site to take such action as they consider necessary for the benefit of the green or other players.
- 9. The greens will be open from the end of April to the start of October, and specific dates will be given each year and listed on the website.
- 10. Application forms must be submitted to the Council by the end of March for a season ticket to be issued.
- 11. a. Bowlers shall not use the rinks in such a way as to cause any nuisance, damage, disturbance, annoyance, inconvenience or interference to any neighbouring or adjoining property.
 - b. Bowlers shall not do any act, matter or thing, which would, or might constitute a breach of any statutory requirement affecting the rinks or which would or might make invalid whole or part any insurance effected in respect of rinks from time to time.
 - c. The Council shall not be liable for the death or injury to or for the damage to any or expenses or other liability incurred by the holder or any person in the exercise of this agreement.

- d. A season ticket agreement shall be terminated immediately on notice served by the Council at any time following any breach. The decision of the Deputy Operations Manager shall be final.
- 12. The Council reserves the right to close the greens to facilitate special events.
- 13. If you are a member of one of the clubs that use the green, your club may have reserved times for members at one of the greens. Please check with your secretary.
