Whilst Brentwood is one of the safest boroughs in Essex. Safer Brentwood and Brentwood Borough Council, with the help of MenShed are launching a new project aimed at elderly and vulnerable residents. We have been awarded funding from the Police & Crime Commissioner to install door chains into homes for <u>FREE</u>.

The primary aim of the project is to make the most vulnerable residents of Brentwood feel safer in their homes.

The door chains are easy to use and improve security when dealing with strangers. Door chains are mainly intended to allow you to open the door slightly and communicate with individuals outside, whilst preventing these individuals from gaining access to your home. Door chains can also be set in place when the door is not open to add extra security to your home.

If you would like to be considered for this project and have a door chain fitted for free, please fill in the simple form below. Once we have received the form, you will be notified within 10 working days if your application has been successful. You will then be contacted by a MenShed volunteer who will arrange a suitable date and time for the door chain to be installed at your property. All volunteers will have undergone appropriate vetting.
