



Historic evolution

Brentwood is, at its heart, a medieval town that developed along the old Roman road from London to Colchester, which followed a series of ridges on higher ground.

The town was a successful trading point and developed as a series of burgage plots congregated around the market place. The evolution of this built form remains legible today.
